
The City of South Pasadena is committed to provide open and transparent access to public records created and maintained by the City, which includes timely access to requested records in accordance with the California Public Records Act (Government Code 6250 et seq).

#### Can I search for records online?

The City of South Pasadena uses a digital document archiving system known as Laserfiche. The City utilizes this system to retrieve, manage, and distribute paper and electronic records more efficiently and effectively. Citizens may access such information through Weblink, which delivers these documents via a familiar web-browser interface. Users can browse, search, retrieve, download, and print City documents. Currently, users can access a variety of documents including the following:

- City Council Agenda Packets, Minutes, Ordinances, and Resolutions.
- Fair Political Practices Commission Statements.
- Contracts and Agreements.
- Advisory Body Agenda and Minutes.



## MMVPG Permits


- There are currently two types of permits available for the MMVPG

- There is no charge to use the MMVPG after 6:00pm on weekdays and all day on weekends

## Permit Parking Operations Time Change

- Changing the hours of operation for Permit Parking at Mission-Meridian Village Parking Garage (MMVPG)
  - Current hours of operation Monday–Friday, 4:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
  - Proposed change of hours of operation Monday–Friday, 4:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
- Purpose
  - To allow for increased utilization of the MMVPG during day time hours in a heavily impacted parking area
- Meeting Park & Ride obligations
  - Gold Line users that purchase a parking permit will still have priority as they usually enter in the morning
  - The change has been discussed and agreed upon by Metro and Clancy

## Purpose & Permits

- The MMVPG is a designated Park & Ride lot
  - Primary purpose is to provide Gold Line users with parking
  - Secondary purpose is to provide additional parking to the Mission Street area after commute hours

## Signage

- Additional signage may be installed to provide better wayfinding to the MMVPG and provide clarity within the MMVPG
- The City applied for a wayfinding grant on November 12, 2015, from the Metro
  - Metro Staff has awarded the City \$13,305 for wayfinding signage
