November 14: Playing Dead (2013) French (104 minutes)

Jean, a 40-year-old unemployed actor, has been set up with a rather odd job; helping the police reconstruct crime scenes by standing in for the dead victim, where he sparks with the officer investigating the real-life crime.

November 28: Labyrinth of Lies (2014) German (124 minutes)

The year is 1958. The war has been over for thirteen years and the Federal Republic of Germany is not only recovering but even booming. But where are the Nazis? Who has ever heard of the death camps? It looks as if everything is for the best in the best of all possible worlds in this land of milk and honey...
