



# Homework Helper State Reports

## Getting Started:

- Ask your school librarian or teacher to help you find materials in your school library.
- When you visit the South Pasadena Public Library, remember to bring your assignment directions or teacher's instructions.
- Check out your state's Office of Tourism online.
- Ask your parents if they belong to a travel or automobile club. Sometimes these clubs will provide free state materials to members.

## Reference Materials:

- Read a general article on the state you've chosen in an encyclopedia such as the *World Book Encyclopedia*. *World Book Online* is available from the Library website at [www.cityofsouthpasadena.us/library](http://www.cityofsouthpasadena.us/library).
- Use the most current encyclopedia or the official state Internet site to locate population figures and other statistical information. In addition to using general encyclopedias on specific states, consult the following reference books:
