SUSPECT DESCRIPTION

SEX: Female

RACE: White, or light skinned Hispanic

AGE: 20 years

HAIR: Long dark brown hair

EYES: Unknown, wore sunglasses

WEIGHT: Medium build

CLOTHING: Gray shirt, black pants, black shoes with dark sunglasses and carrying a black notebook.



Suspect Vehicle: White, 4-door sedan

LOSS: Fed Ex envelope containing credit cards.

On 3-17-16, at about 4:40 PM, the above suspect drove up and parked in front of the victim's residence (2000 block of Milan Avenue, South Pasadena, CA) and exited the vehicle. The suspect was carrying a notebook and walked up to the front door and picked up the Fed Ex envelope which was lying on the victim's front porch. The suspect concealed the envelope in her notebook then left and fled in the vehicle. Suspect may be following Fed Ex vehicles as there was another Fed Ex envelope in the suspect's notebook.

The envelope contained credit cards issued to the victim. The suspect used the credit card to make an unauthorized charge at an unknown Jack in the Box in Los Angeles.
